

Content

The call addresses WWTF-funded researchers

- to develop a specific concept to transfer and spread the acquired scientific knowledge and project results to a broader audience (one main transfer activity).
- to implement innovative activities which will allow the project to reach new stakeholders (not scientific community).

Main characteristics of a NEXT project (I)



NEXT-projects are small projects that raise established know-how to the next level towards application and

- ...go beyond the scientific project and results that were generated via WWTF funding (with or without commercialization),
- ...have the potential for additional societal and/or economic benefit,
- ...include the description of a new target group that could be interested in the exciting scientific results (not the scientific community itself).

Main characteristics of a NEXT project (II)




Included: prototypes, spin-offs, patents, licences, new industry cooperations... + dissemination of acquired knowledge to new societal players/user groups (trainings, guidelines, counselling, social businesses,...)

Not within the scope: classical science communication projects (open lectures, media coverage, media co-operations,...) + mere continuation of existing activities and the scientific project itself and already established collaborations

Evaluation Process



Formal check by WWTF Office

- Online submission until deadline
- All required signatures from the appropriate persons
- Minimum in-kind contributions

Jury meeting

- Assessment by at least two jury members
- Funding recommendation through a jury (national & international experts)

Formal decision

- WWTF boards formally confirms jury recommendation
- Information of applicants about decision



Evaluation Criteria (I)



Scope

- ...as described in the call specifications. Projects which are not within the thematic scope will be immediately rejected by the jury, i.e. the NEXT-project must be based on results of an already funded WWTF project.

Innovative and focused idea/step towards valorization

Does the project tackle a specific and concrete innovative idea how to (re)use scientific results? The continuation of the scientific work (e.g. publications etc.) or add-ons of the already running project is not within the scope.

Feasibility and implementation

— Are the work plan and time schedule feasible? Are the stated goals adequate/process to reach them traceable?

Evaluation Criteria (II)



New target group(s)

— Is the project able to reach a concrete new target group and if possible, to foster and increase the spread of exploitable research results? The scientific community is NOT a possible target group in this sense. Is there a basic understanding of the market of this new target group and potential competitors?

Resources

– Are the personnel and non-personnel costs in regard to the idea adequate. Is there evidence of a minimum amount of in-kind contributions (<35% of funding volume). Do the qualifications of the team members fit to the project?

Evaluation Criteria (III)



Additionality

Does the project support additional benefits arising from the WWTF funding (increase in quality, scope,...)?

Relevance, impact and sustainability

— Is there an impact of the proposed work on the target group and/or generally on society and economy (commercialization potential, market value,...) and what is the grade of sustainability?

Consideration of gender aspects


 The relevance of potential sex-specific and gender-related aspects of the proposed projects should be considered and explained throughout the proposal.

WWTF | Gender Equality Strategy & Plan (I)



WWTF aims to:


- play an active role in closing the gender gap in science and research
- further improve processes and conditions to increase the proportion of female scientists, their resources and career opportunities
- reach and sustain gender equality
- avoid bias in the assessment and evaluation process



WWTF | Gender Equality Strategy & Plan (II)



- Evaluation criteria that account for career breaks & atypical career paths (e.g. care duties)
- WWTF encourages balanced teams & more female researchers to apply as PIs of research projects
- Consideration of research in content.
- Guidance is given in the call specifications and further documents (checklist)

- Submission is only possible after the form has been completed in its entirety
- No amendments can be made after the submission
- Application must be written in English





- Eligible are PIs of already WWTF funded projects with an affiliation at a Viennese research invitation
- Right to submit can be transferred to a group member (→ please contact WWTF office)
- Only one NEXT-project can be submitted by each funded WWTF project
- Each NEXT-project must have a minimum of one LOI of a new target group
- Additional project partners and collaborators are possible as team members
