

Introduction to the WWTF



WWTF: Key facts

- ➤ The only larger Austrian private non-profit organisation established to promote science and research
- ➤ Founded in 2001 | Funding since 2003: over € 165 Mio. have been awarded (Private foundation, City of Vienna)
- WWTF Mission:
 - We fund top scientific research in Vienna
 - We provide substantial funding for larger research projects and international research group leaders coming to Vienna
 - ► We run competitive calls according to highest international standards

The frame of the current call

- ► Focus on long-term funding of Life Sciences in Vienna
- ► Regular competitive calls with thematic focus

Details of the Life Sciences 2021 Call

Details of the LS21 call

- 2 stage selection process:
 - Short proposal deadline: 13.04.2021
 - ► Full proposal deadline: 24.08.2021
- Funding range: € 200,000 € 700,000*
- ▶ 2 4 year research projects on cutting-edge research
- ➤ Total budget: € 4.5 Mio

Scope of the Chemical Biology call

- Research that embraces interface between chemistry and biology
- Aims to understand or manipulate biological systems with molecular precision

May include:

- Development or application of new tools and techniques
- Studies to probe mechanism, interaction or structure of biological macromolecules, compartments and systems
- Leads to solutions in life sciences, biotechnology and human health
- Do not have to include translational/clinical aspect
- Go beyond classical molecular biology or genetics methods

Scope of the Chemical Biology call

- Substantial contributions from both biology and chemistry
- Expertise may be covered within research group
- Bring together researchers from diverse disciplines

Brought forward by:

- Biologists interested in understanding and manipulating biological processes at the molecular level, or
- Chemists applying the principles and tools of organic and/or physical chemistry to biological questions
- NB: a researcher may appear in two proposals at most

WWTF Gender Policy

Our objectives are to:


- to implement gender-neutral processes
- raise awareness of gender bias (applicants, reviewers, panels)
- encourage balanced teams & more female researchers to apply as PIs
- use evaluation criteria that account for career breaks and atypical career paths e.g. due to family circumstances
- ▶ Inclusion of potential sex-specific or gender-related aspects in the respective parts of the proposal (details in "Including sex and gender considerations in WWTF proposals and research teams.doc" online)

WWTF Projects


- Up to 3 researchers per project core team (Short Proposal)
- One designated coordinator (PI)
- Coordinator must be affiliated to a university or non-university research institute in Vienna
- Project partners (co-PIs) can be based worldwide. Up to 20% of funding for researchers may be allocated outside Vienna

Joint Projects: since 2020

- Collaboration between researchers in Vienna and Lower Austria
 - PI in Vienna, co-PI in Lower Austria
 - ➤ Vienna: min. 51% budget
 - ▶ Lower Austria: 20% 49% budget
 - ▶ Optional: other partners up to 20% budget
- Funding: up to extra € 70,000 per project (total maximum € 770,000)
- Regional branches of Viennese institutions located in Lower Austria are considered Viennese partners





Schedule of the Chemical Biology call




Submission via WWTF Online Submission System

- Strict deadline (13th April at 2pm)
- Submission only possible when all parts and uploads are complete
- No data or figures at this stage (only Gantt chart)
- WWTF office performs formal eligibility check
- Proposals then sent to jury for pre-assessment








Jury recommendation

Main evaluation criteria:

- Scientific quality and innovativeness
- Scope and relevance of the project
- Appropriate approach to address clear research question
- Feasibility of proposal, considering resources and timeframe
- Interdisciplinarity, collaboration, expertise and team composition
- Consideration of sex-specific or gender-related aspects

Decision

- Formal decision by the board of directors
- All applicants will receive a decision letter (acceptance or rejection) with anonymous reviews



Using the Submission System

- Register with name and e-mail address at https://funding.wwtf.at
- Login, "my proposals", select the call and click on "create a new proposal"
- Complete the proposal, upload necessary documents, and submit (a PDF file with a project number will be generated automatically)
 - Submission is only possible after the form has been completed in its entirety
 - No amendments can be made after the submission
- Write in English: precise, address criteria, provide sufficient detail
- No diagrams or pictures, except for Gantt chart



Project Proposal

- Project summary
- Introduction, background and state of the art
- Objectives & hypotheses
- Expected results, novelty & relevance
- Methods & feasibility
- Role of team members, interdisciplinary collaborative aspects
- Key references (max. 10)
- Text box input fields, character number limited (incl. spaces)
- If applicable: consider sex-specific or gender-related aspects
- Keep applications short and precise
 - use language aimed at the scientific community
 - be ambitious
 - in English

Gantt Chart

- ► PDF upload, max. one page
- Include WP and responsibilities
- No data allowed

Ethical Aspects

- ▶ If the project requires approval by the ethics committee or has already been approved, provide a brief statement (include approval #)
- It is the researcher's responsibility to comply with ethics regulations
- Refer to guide for details and deadlines

Submission system: Budget



Budget

- Overhead costs: up to 20% of the direct costs
- No funding of companies or industry partners
- Self-funded business partners are possible
- Project relevant services from companies can be calculated as non-personnel costs (if these services cannot be provided with reasonable effort by the team itself)
- ▶ Non-personnel costs should not exceed 40% of the total budget
- Budget changes in the full proposal stage are permitted, but require justification

Cost Planning Tool





Budget

Spreadsheet download to help calculate the budget:

- Per institution and per year calculations
- Personnel costs
 - in-kind and WWTF funding, use FTE/100% salary
 - Includes automatic 3% annual salary increase
 - WWTF policy regarding senior staff: up to 20% in case there is less than 40% basic institutional block funding
- Non-personnel costs (consumables, third-party services, travelling, publishing costs)
- Do not submit the spreadsheet
- Use the derived numbers to fill in the table online
- Insert numbers in € k (€ 100,000 = € 100 k)





Submission system: Signatures



- WWTF-projects are § 27-projects (for universities)
 - A commitment from the involved universities or research institution is necessary since the coordinator's institution will be the official contract partner
 - ► Affirmations: Signature of the PIs / Core team members
 - ➤ Authorization: Signature of the authorized person from the involved institutions of the PIs / Core team members
 - ▶ Be aware of internal regulations of the respective institutions
 - Contact the research services unit/grant managers in advance

Submission system: Signatures



- ▶ PDFs will be generated automatically using the information about the core team and hosting institutions
- "Download Part I as PDF document"
- Regular or electronic signatures permitted
 - Print page, sign, scan and upload OR
 - Save individual page, insert e-signature and upload as PDF: do NOT afterwards alter PDF in any form (e.g. merge, edit)
- ▶ Up to 6 files, max. 6 pages

Affirmations

In signing the application form, all persons involved (project manager, partners) undertake that the information provided in the application form is, to the best of their knowledge and belief, accurate and complete. They confirm the following:

- . All relevant material changes will be promptly communicated to WWTF
- All persons agree not to exploit intellectual property as individuals, but, if in any way possible, within the set of rules of their Home institutions. All publications have to mention WWTF as a funding institution.
- The persons involved will ensure compliance with all legal and procedural requirements regarding safety, ethic issues, notification requirements and any other relevant regulations.
- The persons involved confirm that the work plan submitted for WWTF funding is currently not subject to third party funding (like FWF, EU-funding, any other regional, national or international funding).
- The persons involved pledge to disclose if they intend to apply / have applied for funding for the same work plan at other funding sources.

- The institution is willing to co-operate with WWTF, in an appropriate way, and its chosen partners regarding the application and
 protection of intellectual property arising from the project to be funded.
